Please note that after the deadline for the abstract submission (May, 1<sup>st</sup>), you can still submit an abstract, but we cannot guarantee its inclusion into the Programme book. We will do our best, especially if the abstract arrives very soon after the deadline.

Same goes for the accommodation booking. Although we do not guarantee the prices nor the availability any longer, we are working with our partners and considering each request in order to find the best possible solution, and will continue to do so until the very conference.
